#### **6<sup>th</sup> Religion**

We will work through some final readings in the Old Testament containing Messianic prophecies this week, and we will begin studying selections from the Gospels.

We are having a quiz on Wednesday over the first three sections of chapter 5. We will finish the week introducing the cross-products method to solving proportions. Our last few sections of chapter 5 deal with slope and direct variation.

**6<sup>th</sup> English**

We will work through a new spelling unit this week. We pushed starting the narrative essay off to this week.

**6<sup>th</sup> History**

We will begin the week presenting our projects on Roman emperors. On Tuesday I will be giving out a review guide for the Rome chapter. We will work on several review tasks to prepare for a test on the chapter, which will be next week Monday.

**8<sup>th</sup> American History**

Our quiz on the 1848-1860 unit will be Tuesday! After that, we begin our unit on the Civil War.

**Debate Elective**
