2nd Grade Sentences

Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Curriculum for this week:

- Religion: God sends his promise through Abraham and Isaac.
- Reading: Finish reading *Iris and Walter*, work in small groups on reading and character/setting identification.
- Spelling: Look over our pre-assessments and see which priority words still need to be mastered; begin working on Unit 1 as we work with the consonant+h digraph sounds of *ch*, *th*, *wh* and *sh*.
- Phonics: Review short vowel sounds.
- Grammar: Review traits of complete sentences and learn that the naming part is called the subject.
- Writing: Practice writing sentences as we begin to create our first class book!
- Math: Act out "some, some more" story problems, compare numbers to 50, compare and order objects by size, take a fact assessment on doubles and begin learning the +0 and +1 facts, practice the problem solving strategies of logical reasoning and act it out, take a written assessment and practice covering a design with pattern blocks.
- Social Studies: Continue to learn about urban, suburban and rural communities; practice using a compass rose to find directions on a map; begin to discover how transportation and communication have changed over time.
- The Social Studies COMMUNITY PHOTOGRAPHY PROJECT assignment goes home TUESDAY. Be sure to look for this and guide your child in completing it!
- Second Step: Begin Unit 1 on Skills for Learning with a lesson on being respectful.
