### Pumpkin Cookies Recipe

½ cup shortening

- 1 1/4 cups brown sugar, firmly packed
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 ½ cups canned pumpkin
- 2 1/2 cups sifted flour
- 4 tsp. baking powder
- ½ tsp. salt
- ½ tsp. ground cinnamon
- ½ tsp. ground nutmeg

Cream together shortening and brown sugar. Add eggs; beat thoroughly. Mix in vanilla and pumpkin.

Sift together dry ingredients. Blend into creamed mixture. Drop dough by heaping teaspoonful about 2" apart onto greased baking sheet. Bake in a preheated oven (375°) about 15 minutes until lightly browned. Remove cookies and cool on racks.
