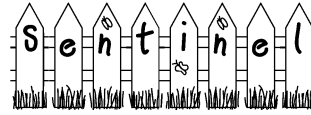

Last week we:

Curriculum for this week:

- Religion: Continue reading of Jesus' teachings as we study the Lord's Prayer, read the parable of the Lost Sheep, and read when Mary Anointed Jesus.
- Reading: Finish reading *Fire Fighter!* by Angela Royston as we review finding main ideas and details; enjoy reading groups.
- Spelling: Work on Unit 14 as we practice words that end with *k/ck* and *ch/tch*.
- Phonics: See how adding different suffixes can change the meaning of a word.
- Grammar: Continue to practice identifying adverbs and the verbs they tell more about.
- Writing: Continue working with the Conventions Trait as we learn the parts of a friendly letter and plan who we'll each send a letter to.
- Math: Practice the -9 facts and begin working on the x5 facts; learn how to tell time to the minute, count and show money with quarters, dimes, nickels and pennies, identify and create parallel lines and line segments, and add 3-digit numbers.
- Science: Begin to explore force, motion and work.
- Second Step: Continue Unit 3 on Emotion Management with a lesson on Handling Making Mistakes.
