Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Last week we:

• Enjoyed creating Wampanoag and Pilgrim Main Idea and Detail turkeys.

Curriculum for this week:

- Religion: Learn about the Church season of Advent, which means "Coming"; continue our unit "Good Times and Bad Times" as we learn about King Saul and David, and see an example of true friendship between David and Jonathan.
- Reading: Continue our unit on working together as we enjoy reading Ronald Morgan Goes to Bat by Patricia Reilly Giff, learning about baseball, and reviewing fantasy and reality story elements.
- Spelling: Finish Unit 5 as we listen for silent letters and take our unit tests.
- Phonics: Begin to identify and create contractions.
- Grammar: Practice writing and using possessive nouns and plural nouns.
- Writing: Share our Personal Narrative masterpieces; continue working on the organization trait as we practice writing a paragraph from an outline; share our special ornament paragraphs as we decorate our classroom Christmas tree.
- Math: Practice the sums of 13 and 14 facts; count money using dimes, pennies, and nickels; learn to identify lines of symmetry and create art using the property of symmetry; work on 2-digit addition without regrouping; practice reading and following a recipe and measuring using measuring cups.
- <u>Social Studies:</u> Continue Unit 2, Our Earth, as we learn what shapes land and water can take and how powerful water can be as it continues to change the shape of our land. We'll also receive our landform project assignment!
- <u>Second Step:</u> Work on Unit 2, Empathy, with a lesson on understanding feelings.
- Continue to memorize Luke 2:1-14 (KJV) and practice for our Christmas program which is coming up on <u>December 17!</u> This year we will have 2 performances, at 6:00 and 7:15. STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE IN <u>BOTH</u> PERFORMANCES while families will sign up to attend 1 of them.
