Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Curriculum for this week:

- <u>Religion:</u> Continue learning about Advent and learn how the Old Testaments prophets foretold Jesus' birth; see how David kept his promise to his friend Jonathan; and hear what Solomon prayed for and how God answered it.
- <u>Reading</u>: Finish our story unit on *Ronald Morgan Goes to Bat* and enjoy a visit from a baseball player, Ryan Sweeney, Myer's dad; begin reading *Turtle's Race With Beaver*, a folk tale retold by Joseph Bruchac and James Bruchac, as we learn about beavers.
- <u>Spelling</u>: Write our Unit 5 Words to Learn; begin Unit 6 as we study how *-ue*, *-ew*, *-ui*, and *-oo* can all sound alike and practice learning how to use to, two, and too correctly.
- <u>Phonics</u>: Practice reading contractions and identifying the words that got contracted.
- <u>Grammar</u>: Learn how pronouns make our writing shorter and can substitute for singular, plural, and possessive nouns.
- <u>Writing</u>: Continue working on paragraph organization as we practice writing a paragraph from an outline, with our fantasy baseball team paragraphs.
- <u>Math</u>: Assess facts with the sums of 13 and 14 and begin to practice facts with sums of 15, 16, 17 and 18; measure to the nearest foot; draw a line segment to create and label a number line; create polygons and identify angles; and use the associative property to add 3 or more single digit numbers.
- <u>Social Studies</u>: Continue learning about our Earth as we look at climate; what natural resources are, and how we can work to best take care of God's creation through the 3 R's.
- Continue to practice for our upcoming Christmas program on December 17 at 6:00 and 7:15. Students are expected to be at BOTH services while families will sign up to attend one of them. Students arrive at 5:45 in our classroom wearing their Christmas best! They can also bring a small snack to have between services.
- Continue practicing our manner of the month, being courteous!
