Dear 2nd Grade Parents,

Last week we:

- Enjoyed settling back into our routines after hearing about each other's break!
- Enjoyed celebrating Gabe Stancik's and Myer Sweeney's 8th birthdays!

Curriculum for this week:

- Religion: Finish our "Bad Times and Good Times" unit by hearing how Solomon built the temple; review all the stories from the unit.
- Reading: Enjoy reading *Pearl and Wagner: Two Good Friends* by Kate McMullan as we explore creative ideas; practice making a story map; enjoy reading groups.
- Spelling: Review how bossy 'e' changes the vowel sound from short to long; review spelling contractions and practice rules for adding endings.
- Phonics: Practice reading words with the long 'e' sound spelled -ee, -ea, -e, or -y.
- Grammar: Get tired out as we explore the active world of verbs!
- Writing: Continue working on paragraph organization as we make an outline and then use the outline to create a paragraph.
- Math: Take the 100 addition fact assessment and practice the -0 and -1 facts; continue mastering 2-digit addition with regrouping; identify and create similar shapes; create and read a Venn diagram; identify AM/PM, noon/midnight, and dozen/half-dozen.
- Science: Continue studying matter as we learn more about properties of materials and begin to visit the three states of matter.
- Social Studies: Learn about the work of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and why we get a day off of school to honor him!
