## Week 21



Dear $2^{\text {nd }}$ Grade Parents,

Curriculum for this week:

- Religion: Begin a new unit, "The Faithless and The Faithful," as we learn how God shared a special message with Elijah and how Elijah helped a widow. Throughout this unit we'll learn how God is faithful. He blesses those who trust His Word, and He's faithful even when we are faithless. We'll meet several people who will illustrate God's promises to protect his people. We'll see that although people sin, we can be assured of God's forgiveness, love, and protection. This truth certainly gives us hope today, as we endure struggles, pandemics, and hardships. The knowledge of God's love and protection gives us courage and comfort!
- Reading: Begin reading Dear Juno by Soyung Pak and practice our reading detective skills as we draw conclusions. As we learn about creative ways to communicate through this story, we'll practice some sign language too!
- Phonics: Practice words with the long o sound spelled with $-0,-\infty$, and -ow.
- Spelling: Continue unit 7 as we practice the spelling rules for adding endings to verbs, crash words together to make contractions, and take the Word Test.
- Grammar: Continue to get tired out as we practice identifying verbs and learn how to make nouns and verbs agree with each other.
- Writing: Continue revising our $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade informational paragraphs as we strengthen our topic sentence, add transitions to our yellow sentences, and beef up the red sentences, all to add detail.
- Math: Assess the -1 and -0 facts and learn the -2 facts; practice adding 32 -digit numbers together; learn how to read a thermometer to the nearest $2^{\circ}$; practice the problem-solving method of guess and check; and create overlapping shapes on a geoboard.
- Science: Continue our study of matter as we explore the states of liquid and gas; design and build a dam to experiment with changing the flow of water.
