Dear 2nd Grade Families.

Curriculum for this week:

- Religion: Review our stories from "The Faithful and The Faithless" unit and take a test; continue in our New Testament stories with Jesus setting the example for us and getting baptized by John the Baptist, which signaled the beginning of his earthly Ministry.
- Reading: Finish our novel study on The New Year Dragon Dilemma by discussing Chapters 12-14, reviewing the story, and taking our test. FRIDAY, 2/18 will be our character dress-up day, where students can dress up as 1 of the characters from the novel.
- Spelling: Begin Unit 9 with the Word Preview.
- Fhonics: Learn how to make compound words and practice reading them.
- * Writing: Finish publishing our 2nd Grade Informational Paragraph!
- Math: Assess the -3 facts and work on the subtracting 4 facts; take a written assessment; practice comparing numbers using >, <, and =; create and read a pictograph with a scale of 2; and identify fractional parts of a set.</p>

 - Finish our Word of the Day and Daily Geography packet.
 - Enjoy reading Lon Po Po, the Chinese version of Little Red Riding Hood, and see how it compares to the version we're used to.

 - End our unit with a dragon parade through the school and a feast in our classroom on Wednesday, 2/16.
- ¥ Learn the story behind Valentine's Day as we learn who St. Valentine was.
- Finjoy celebrating Valentine's Day with stories and games to review skills, and practice the figurative language that makes valentine cards funny!
- F Learn about George Washington and Abraham Lincoln and why we have a day off to honor them.
