Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Last week we:

- heard some parting words from Miss Hoffman as she finished her time in 2nd grade! Thank you so much for all the wonderful supplies you donated to her basket! Check the album for pictures!

Curriculum for this week:

- **Religion:** Begin Unit 6, Miracles of Jesus, as we focus on Jesus as true God and true man, and His power over sin, death, and the devil. We'll see Jesus' compassion and love this week as he heals a paralyzed man, cures the ten lepers, and brings a widow's son back to life.
- **Reading:** Begin Unit 4, Our Changing World; read *The Quilt Story* by Tony Johnston as discover the history behind quilts; practice comparing and contrasting information both on the surface level and on a deeper level; and connect the quilt from the story to a security item in our own lives.
- **Spelling:** Study Unit 10 as we practice using tricky homophones, study compounds and idioms, practice words with the long 'e' and long 'i' sound spelled with -y; and play "I Spy With My Proofreading Eye".
- **Grammar:** Unlock words with multiple meanings and see how they can be used as nouns or verbs.
- **Phonics:** Learn to decode multi-syllable words that end with the (*consonant*)le syllable, which is considered a final stable syllable.
- **Writing:** Begin learning how to write to compare or contrast.
- **Math:** Practice and assess the -6 facts and begin practicing the -7 facts; model making groups of 10 and discover how to multiply by 10; identify and count quarters, learn how to round a 2-digit number to the nearest 10; and take a written assessment and practice estimating an amount.
- **Science:** Continue exploring God's magnificent creation of the Solar System as we see how the Sun determines seasons. We'll also learn about our moon and its phases, as well as begin studying the planets.
- We'll also have a wee bit of fun as we learn about who St. Patrick was and how we can use the shamrock to teach about the Triune God!

Let's have a blessed week in Christ as we begin 4th Quarter!
