# Dear 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Families.

### Curriculum for this week:

- <u>Religion</u>: Continue learning about Jesus' miracles including when he calmed a storm and when He fed 5,000. These miracles prove Jesus has power over nature and our physical needs, which is always a comfort to be reminded of!
- <u>Reading:</u> Enjoy reading Frogs, by Gail Gibbons, as we learn about the life cycles of frogs and continue our theme of "Our Changing World"; practice differentiating between facts and opinions; compare and contrast frogs and toads.
- Spelling: Finish Unit 10 by taking our tests.
- <u>Phonics:</u> Practice reading words that end with a (consonant)+le final syllable.
- <u>Grammar:</u> Begin to explore the wonderfully descriptive world of adjectives.
- <u>Writing:</u> Continue learning how to write to compare and contrast.
- <u>Math:</u> Practice the -7 facts; learn how to divide both even and odd amounts into 2, and determine if there's a remainder; practice rounding numbers to estimate a sum as a way of checking; and measure with feet and inches.
- <u>Science</u>: Finish our unit on the Solar System by doing projects. We'll each choose an object to learn more about then do research and learn how to take notes.
