

Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Curriculum for this week:

- **Religion:** Finish our journey to the cross during this Holy Week as we hear how Peter Denies Jesus, and read about Jesus' suffering, death, and burial in a tomb. We'll learn why we call it "Good" Friday as we understand why Jesus did what He did.
- **Reading:** Finish reading *I Like Where I Am*, a poem story by Jessica Harper; practice identifying a story's plot and theme; enjoy reading groups; and begin a new reading theme, "Responsibility".
- **Phonics:** Practice using and finding words that have *-oi/-oy* in them.
- **Spelling:** Finish Unit 12 as we practice being a thesaurus and coming up with better words for some overused ones; apply the rules of spelling changes when adding endings; and take our tests.
- **Grammar:** Continue working with nouns, verbs, and adjectives as we explore multiple meaning words.
- **Writing:** Finish working on our Solar System report as we turn our notes into a 4 paragraph essay, while still using the same organization strategy we learned for paragraph writing.
- **Math:** Practice and assess the -8 facts; take a written assessment; measure using centimeters; learn how to do x1 and x100 facts; and discover what perimeter is and how to find it.
- **Social Studies:** Continue our Unit on America's Past and Symbols as we see how explorers shaped our nation, learn what life as an early settler was like, and learn about America's birthday and the events of the Revolutionary War.
