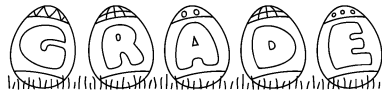

Curriculum for this week:

- **Religion:** Celebrate with joy Jesus' resurrection on Easter and see how he appeared to His disciples to prove He was alive!
- **Reading:** Begin theme 5, "Responsibility" and start studying *Fire Fighter!* by Angela Royston as we review finding main ideas and details.
- **Phonics:** Practice adding the suffixes -ly, -ful, -or, and -er and learn how they change the meaning of the word.
- **Grammar:** review parts of speech as we create a Spring Mad Libs.
- **Spelling:** Begin Unit 13 with the Word Preview and practice the commonly confused words of *were, we're, whirl, where* and *wear*.
- **Writing:** Begin our fiction narrative unit! We'll do prewriting to plan our story's problem, solution, and plot; develop our characters; and learn about point of view to determine which perspective we'll use in our stories.
- **Math:** Begin practicing the -9 facts; learn how to tell time to the minute; count money amounts with quarters, dimes, nickels, and pennies together; and identify parallel lines.
- **Social Studies:** Continue to learn America's past as we study the Constitution, Civil War, Underground Railroad, and the expansion of our nation with the pioneers and immigrants.
- **Curriculum Fair:** We finished creating our Measurement Sculptures during Math. Now, we move our project into writing as our sculpture becomes the setting of a fiction narrative. Come see our finished work at Bethany's Curriculum Fair on Friday, May 6 from 6:30-7:30!
