
Week 34

Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Curriculum for this week:

- <u>Religion:</u> Finish Unit 6, Jesus' Miracles, with the lessons of Jesus walking on water, healing a sick boy, and healing a blind man. These miracles all showed Jesus' power over nature and illness and remind us that He is able to take care of us!
- <u>Reading:</u> Finish learning about fire fighters while we practice identifying main ideas and details; begin reading Red, White, and Blue: The Story of the American Flag by John Herman as we learn more about this important symbol, and practice identifying facts and opinions.
- <u>Spelling:</u> Finish Unit 13 by applying reviewing the long 'o' spellings of -o, old, and -ow; practice words with silent letters, and take our tests.
- <u>Phonics:</u> Practice reading and identifying words with suffixes (-ly, -ful, -er, and -or).
- <u>Grammar:</u> Discover that articles (and, an, the) are a special type of adjective and practice using them.
- Writing: Draft our fiction narratives for our curriculum fair projects.
 We'll then begin revising them as we focus on character development, show don't tell, and using dialogue.
- <u>Math:</u> Practice and test the -9 facts and learn the x5 facts; add 3-digit numbers with regrouping; problem solve making an organized list; measure weight in pounds; and practice reading and showing mixed number amounts.
- <u>Social Studies</u>: Continue our unit on America's past and symbols as we learn about the pioneers and immigrants, practice using a timeline, learn more about our own family's immigrant ancestors, learn how federal and local government is structured, and explore some famous buildings in Washington D.C.
- <u>Curriculum Fair:</u> We can't wait to show you our Measurement Sculptures and our fiction narratives based on them! Join us on Friday, May 6 from 6:30-7:30 in the gym to see our work!
- Begin our last round of MAP Testing for the year!
- Make a thank you project for the firefighters at Station 8.
