

Dear 2nd Grade Families,

Last week we:

- enjoyed celebrating Elizabeth's birthday with tasty treats!

- did a great job sharing our 2nd grade informational paragraphs with the 1st graders, since they were our intended audience.

Curriculum for this week:

- <u>Religion:</u> Begin our unit on Jesus' Ministry as we read about the miraculous catch of fish, Jesus at the home of Mary and Martha, and the parables of the Good Samaritan and the Widow's Mite.
- <u>Reading:</u> finish reading Red, White, and Blue: The Story of the American Flag by John Herman as we learn more about this important symbol, and practice identifying facts and opinions.
- Spelling: Finish Unit 13 by identifying silent letters and taking our tests.
- <u>Phonics:</u> Read words with inflected endings (s, ed, ing) and review the spelling change rules for adding them.
- Grammar: Learn what an adverb is and begin using them in writing.
- Writing: Finish revising our fiction narratives to go with our measurement sculptures as we learn strategies for writing the ending, practice the show don't tell technique, and edit transitions and paragraphs. We'll also publish our final copies to share with everyone at the Curriculum Fair on Friday, 5/6!
- <u>Math:</u> Practice and assess the x5 facts, and learn the x2 facts; practice identifying and writing fractions as mixed numbers; use a bar graph with a scale of 2; and identify right angles.
- <u>Social Studies:</u> study many different U.S. symbols and landmarks, such as the Statue of Liberty, The Star Spangled Banner, the Pledge of Allegiance, and Mount Rushmore while also singing several patriotic songs.
- Finish our spring round of MAP tests.
- Look for a signup to come out this week for how you can help make our class patriotic party on Monday, May 9 possible!
