Last week we:

- Worked extremely hard to finish several projects, including our Curriculum Fair projects! It was so fun to hear everyone's creations come to life through story!

Curriculum for this week:

- Religion: Continue Unit 8, Jesus' Ministry, with Jesus teaching about prayer, the parable of the Lost Sheep and Coin, and when Mary Anointed Jesus.
- Reading: Read One Dark Night by Hazel Hutchins as we explore responsibility in taking care of pets; learn about storms; and practice sequencing story events to summarize plot and theme.
- Spelling: Finish Unit 13 as we review words with silent letters and take our tests.
- Phonics: See how adding different prefixes can change the meaning of a word.
- Grammar: Continue working to identify adjectives and adverbs.
- Writing: Learn the parts of a friendly letter; meet the comma and its many jobs as a punctuation mark.
- Math: Practice the $\times 2$ facts, and review ALL the subtraction facts; use 1" tiles to find area; draw pictures to solve equal group story problems, then write multiplication number sentences to represent the pictures; create and identify intersecting and perpendicular lines; and learn how to subtract 3-digit numbers with regrouping.
- Social Studies: wrap up our unit on America's past and symbols with our test and then celebrate our patriotism with our Patriotic Party on Monday, 5/9!
- Science: Begin a unit on Force and Motion as we start to learn what forces are, how we use them, and what work is.
