## Curriculum for this week:

- <u>Religion:</u> Finish our unit on Jesus' Ministry with the story of Zacchaeus. We'll then begin the unit Spreading the Good News with the Easter catch of fish, Jesus' Ascension, and the birthday of the Church, Pentecost.
- <u>Reading:</u> Enjoy reading *Cowboys*, by Lucille Recht Penner, as we
  practice identifying cause and effect relationships; explore the
  tale genre with tall tales, fables, folk tales and fairy tales.
- <u>Phonics</u>: Practice reading and identifying words with prefixes.
- <u>Spelling:</u> Work through Unit 22 as we practice tricky spellings, review properly using possessive nouns and contractions, and take our tests.
- Grammar: Learn how the comma can be used to join sentences or clauses.
- Writing: Draft and revise our friendly letters as we practice conventions. Students will choose the person they're writing to on Monday so look for a note with how you can help!
- <u>Math:</u> Assess the x2 facts and practice the x3 facts; take a
  written assessment; experiment with probability; make and label
  an array to model multiplication; and tell time to the quarter hour.
- <u>Science</u>: Continue exploring force and motion as we experiment with building a strong bridge, discover what friction is and how it effects motion, and explore the world of magnets.
